Community event will go ahead despite attempts of saboteur

Creech St Michael will be holding a community day despite attempts from a mysterious saboteur who has been removing posters about the event for months. Party in the Park Afterdark will happen from 7pm in the recreation park at Creech and is a ticketed event (£2.50 adults, £1 child, under 4 free). There will be a kids disco, 12 piece funk band Groovilicious, hog roast, licenced bar, inflatable slide and floodlit play area.
